How does Gwasanaeth Cerdd work?

We work with schools to provide music lessons for children and young people. So, if you are interested in receiving lessons, let the school know and the music teacher will contact us at Gwasanaeth Cerdd Ysgolion to make the necessary arrangements.

You don't need any musical talent and it doesn't matter how old you are either. All you need is enthusiasm.

Lessons start at the beginning of the academic year and the school will arrange a timetable with the music tutors. Up to 30 lessons a year are provided.

The school will decide how much you will pay – but lessons with Gwasanaeth Cerdd Ysgolion are much cheaper than private lessons outside school. You will be paying the school directly.

What instruments are there to choose from?

We can provide lessons in most orchestral and band instruments – including brass and wind instruments, string, percussion, the harp, the piano and, of course, singing lessons. The full list can be found on our website.

Borrowing instruments – free of charge

Musical instruments can be expensive – and this can sometimes put people off having lessons. By learning to play an instrument with us you need not worry about the cost of buying an instrument when you start off.

If you don't have access to an instrument yourself, or you want to try before you buy, you can borrow any instrument from us free of charge for two years. Ask at school or get in touch with your music teacher for more information.
